In the past year, our net financial assets have increased by 694,000\$ to 1,716,896\$

- Debt decreased to 611,925\$
- Cash on hand has grown to 2,871,947\$

This prudent money management over the years will allow us to undertake major infrastructure work.

Over the course of my past three terms, we, as a community, have successfully:

1) purchased the landfill property that we were previously leasing from the MNRF; our landfill now has a life expectancy of 162 years

2) reduced the debt per household from \$1000 to \$478

3) welcomed new businesses, such as a massage therapy clinic, a pharmacy and a dental hygienist

4) seen a new daycare service being offered at our school in addition to major renovations to the school itself

5) secured a grant for a new excavator with trailer (no cost to the community)

6) purchased a new grader

7) creation of a local food bank and a bi-weekly meal service available for delivery; THANKS TO OUR VOLUNTEERS that run these services!

Current on-going projects & lobbying:

- continued efforts of recruiting more healthcare professionals to our community
- the installation of Fibre Optic (accessible to more residents of the community in this next phase)
- natural gas coming to our community
